
Type RX Connection



Prior to making a connection, read and follow the full instruction sheet IPRF, the full instruction sheet shipped with ERICO®CADWELD® (IPX), and special instructions below.

- 1. Insert sleeve on cable, letting cable end protrude .13" [3.2 mm] to .25" [6.4 mm] beyond end of sleeve.
- 2. Flatten sleeve flare at two places as noted in sketch to allow sleeve body to lay against
- 3. Place a small amount of ERICO CADWELD mold sealer at Point "A" on sketch between sleeve and rail and at flared end or sleeve.
- Place sleeved cable end against rail and position locked mold on cable with flare of 4. sleeve against mold. Cable end should be approx. .13" [3.2 mm] back from center of mold as noted in top sketch.
- 5. Loosely clamp mold to rail using "C" clamp.
- 6. Roll packing and position into opening between mold, sleeve and rail (Point "B")
- 7. Tighten "C" clamp.
- 8. Pack all openings around sleeve and at bottom of rail at mold with ERICO CADWELD mold sealer.
